Conditions:

Due to new additions to an existing middle school, the existing travel distance will become non-compliant. Currently the travel distance is approximately 249 ft, with the addition travel distance will be approximately 273 ft from a storage room off of the Media Center. Code allows travel distance to be up to 250 ft.

Facts:

- 1. The entire school, new and existing, are protected with an automatic fire suppression system per NFPA 13
- 2. An existing smoke detection system will be maintained in the corridors, and will be extended into the corridors of the new construction and the entire system will be connected into the fire alarm system.
- 3. Previous Indiana Building Codes allowed up to a 100 ft increase in the travel distance (325 ft total) in sprinklered schools, when the increased distance was within a corridor.
- 4. Similar variances for schools have been approved: Center Grove HS Activity Center (300 ft) [16-07-51], Zionsville HS (335 ft) [14-02-32(b)], Columbus North High School (310 ft) [09-09-20(b)], Brownsburg HS Classroom Addition & Preforming Arts (280 ft) [07-09-10], Brownsburg HS Renovation and Additions 2017 (17-03-71) (320 ft)
