Conditions: An art exhibit featuring a flame and a fire pit will be located on the 2nd level outdoor terrace, and within 25 feet of the building exterior wall. Based upon classification as a recreational fire, location withing 25 feet of a structure is not permitted.

The Hyatt project includes a 15-story hotel structure, with an adjacent 7-story parking garage.
