Conditions: Fire shutters at existing windows/doors in an existing 2-hour wall between office area and natatorium, and between natatorium and corridor, will not be maintained and will be removed during construction of the addition.

The project includes a new addition with corridor/vestibule, concessions, athletic offices and restrooms. The building is 2-stories, Type IIB construction and classified as Group E occupancy.

Facts: 1. The addition will be fully sprinklered. Sprinklers will be extended to the existing office area as part of the addition project.

2. Closely spaced sprinklers will be provided at the openings (6 feet o.c., 12 inches from openings).

3. The doors will have closers.

4. Variance 18-02-55(C) was previously approved to permit non-rated openings between the natatorium and new addition.
