Conditions:

A 2 hour fire barrier will be provided in lieu of a fire wall in order to separate buildings. Code requires that a fire wall be provided when creating separate buildings. The project consists of the partial demolition and rebuild/expansion of an MOB attached to a hospital. A majority of the separation wall is currently a 2 hour fire barrier that is not being demolished.

- 2. The use of a 2 hour fire barrier is permitted by the 2012 Life Safety Code NFPA 101
- (enforced on this project by ISDH and CMS)
 3. Similar variances allowing fire barriers in lieu of fire walls have been granted on numerous healthcare facilities in the past (16-06-41, 18-08-29, 19-04-51 and 19-12-36 to name a few).

Facts:	The hardship would be the cost and physical limitations of demolishing the existing 2 hour fire barrier that is planned to remain in tact and in use in order to build a 3 hour fire wall. The 2 hour fire barrier currently serves as a separation between differing construction types. Also the added components of a fire wall that include exterior wall extensions and opening protectives (doors, windows, fire dampers).
